Whilst our school students do not compete in weekend competitions under the school banner, many children from within our school, form teams to participate in weekend sporting competitions.




Website

As part of our parent communication, we use a program/App called Compass. As you will see, Compass will allow the school to provide parents with up-to-date information instantly. As a parent, you can either utilise this app on our website, or on any of your mobile devices. Just download the app and use it as a helpful tool for all things school and student related.





Fees and Responsibilities

School fees are billed in the first week of term 1 each year. Your school fees are due and payable 30 days from invoice. Each family is required to complete a Diocesan School Fee Installment Agreement, and return it to the school office no later than 30 days from your 1st statement date, confirming your preferred payment method and payment schedule for that school year. Weekly, fortnightly or monthly payment plans are available, but full payment of your account is required by the first week of December in that school year. If you are experiencing dire financial circumstances, you are encouraged to make direct contact with our school principal to discuss your situation, or to make direct contact with the Diocesan School Fees Liaison officer to make an application for fee relief.

Discount is offered on the tuition component of fees, when you have two or more children enrolled in any Diocesan school.

Child 1 - 0% (tuition only)

Child 2 - 20% (tuition only)

Child 3 - 50% (tuition only)

Child 4+ - 90% (tuition only)
